

Put a Stop to those Annoying Pop-Up Ads!



Chesnee's High-Speed Internet service includes *FREE* Panicware Pop-Up Stopper. With Pop-Up Stopper, you can combat those annoying pop-up ads that can slow down your web surfing and frustrate your time on the Internet.

Note for MAC users: Panicware does not provide a free version of Pop-Up Stopper for MAC users. The only Panicware Pop-Up Stopper for MAC users is Pop-Up Zapper, and costs \$20. MAC users should visit www.panicware.com/product_popupzapper.html for more details and to purchase the software.

Instructions for Windows Users

You can access the download link for the free version of the Pop-Up Stopper from the Panicware website, at http://www.panicware.com/product_psfree.html. You will also find the following instructions on the Panicware page:

- Click on "Download"
- Choose the "Free Version" and click "Download" – the file you are downloading is called PopUpStopperFree.exe
- You will be asked to save the file to a common download folder, or your desktop. Be sure to record where you download the file. The file is small, and should take less than a minute to download.

Installation

Once the download is complete, you can install the program.

- Open the folder or go to the location where you downloaded the PopUpStopperFree.exe file on your computer.
- Close all other programs, including browsers and e-mail
- Double-click the .exe file, and the Install Wizard will begin to install Pop-Up Stopper.
- Click the Next button to continue installation.
- After installation is complete, click the Finish button; you are now ready to begin Set-up.

- Set-up provides more detail about the product, and asks you to choose your preferences on how it works and looks, as well as asking you for an e-mail address to send updates and information.

After you have set your preferences and answered the questions, the Pop-Up Stopper will start the next time you open a web browser. You will be able to tell it is running by the white-hand icon that will appear in the system tray at the bottom right of your Windows screen.

The Pop-Up Stopper will block all pop-up and pop-under screens that attempt to open, unless you hold down the Ctrl button to override the stopper. In addition, some pop-ups are not ads; rather, they present a site link to which you may wish to be connected. In such cases, you can access the site by holding down the Ctrl key and clicking on the link again. Over a short period of time, Pop-Up Stopper may learn your preferred sites and not block them.

Un-Install

To un-install the Pop-Up Stopper, click on the Start button on the lower left of your screen, go to Settings, Control Panel, double-click on the Add/Remove Programs icon, scroll down to Pop-Up Stopper Free Edition and highlight it. Then click the Add/Remove button at the bottom of the screen and follow the directions.
